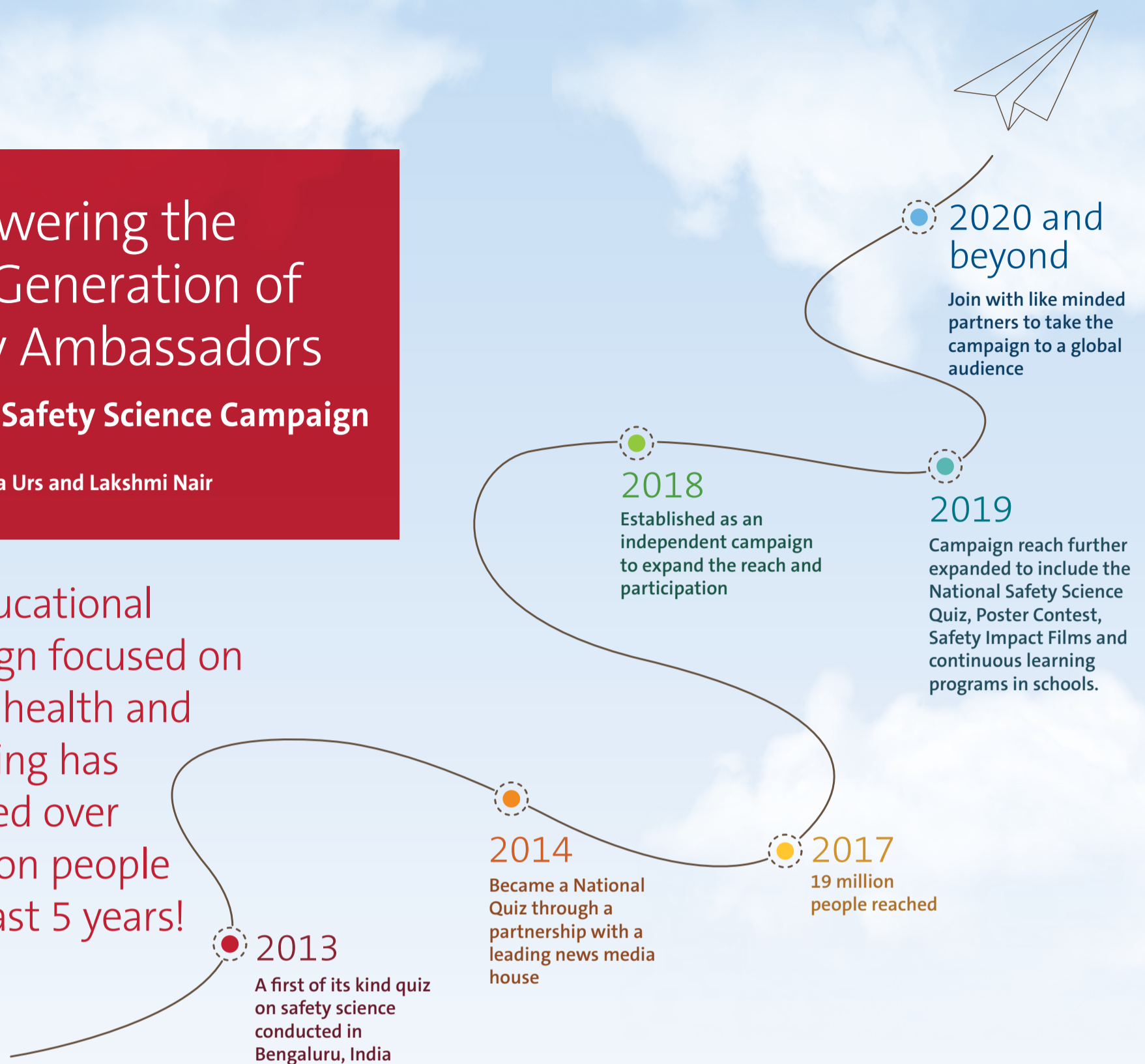


Empowering the Next Generation of Safety Ambassadors

Continuous Learning Programs

Created two programs to institutionalize safety science as a discipline in schools, with the vision to see it added to the present curriculum and become part of everyday learning.

- Safer Schools Safer India:** A fire safety learning program for primary grade class rooms, currently executed through partnerships using a 'train the trainer' approach.
- Safety Clubs:** A hands-on instruction module for middle school learners that covers topics of fire safety, road safety, drowning, falls as well as foreign bodies and poisonings.
